Chalice Lighter History

Chalice Lighters are a collection of members and friends of Unitarian Universalist congregations who pool their contributions into grants awarded to member congregations in the Thomas Jefferson District.

In 1987, the District initiated the program, which has grown to become one of the largest Chalice Lighter programs in the Unitarian Universalist Association. Participants have contributed almost \$3/4 million for more than 45 grants distributed to congregations in its District.

The pledge money is donated mostly in \$15 or \$25 checks. Those individual checks combine to give a significant boost to a member congregation for a growth project.

In 1988, our first grant was not quite \$3,000. Today, the typical grant exceeds \$20,000. That's many small checks pooled to make a huge impact.

Chalice Lighter Grants

To encourage growth, Chalice Lighter (CL) grant criteria are flexible. The CL Committee encourages congregations to be creative in their plans for growth. Congregations must, however, demonstrate how their proposed projects will grow and strengthen Unitarian Universalism.

Grants may be made for traditional projects such as: Calling a minister, hiring a religious education professional, volunteer coordinator, music director, or other staff; buying a building or land; constructing a new building or renovating an existing one; or establishing a campus ministry.

Innovative growth plan examples include: New signage or other ways to increase visibility; innovative adult or youth programming; video broadcasting of program(s); innovative advertising or community relations, including new web sites; satellite or branch church startup; outreach program to enhance diversity in congregation; two or more congregations working together.
